Subj: UNIFORM REGULATIONS

1. Purpose. To publish instructions as to the prescribed uniform for Marine Aircraft Group 12 personnel stationed at Marine Corps Air Station, Iwakuni, Japan.

2. Cancellation. GruO 1020.2H

3. Summary of Revision. This order has been reformatted and contains major changes reflecting the policy established in reference (a).

4. Information. Uniform regulations set forth in references, (a) and (b) are applicable to all members of this command based at, deployed to or attached to MAG-12. This order is intended to ensure that all MAG-12 units maintain a high standard of military appearance at all times.

### 5. Uniforms

a. Uniform of the day. The uniform of the day is that uniform authorized for wear when performing formal or informal duties such as inspections, parades, and leave or liberty. The uniform of the day is normally camouflage utilities or flight suit (if authorized). If the Service "A" or "C" uniform is required, it will be announced by separate bulletin. While in the utility uniform, Marines will only wear Marine Corps issued backpacks. Civilian backpacks which are black, brown, or dark green may be hand carried.

b. Utility Uniform. The utility uniform may be worn on board the station, to and from off station domicile and in all station facilities, unless separately authorized dress codes prohibit its wear. Personnel residing off station and wearing the utility uniform to and from their authorized place of residence are not permitted to make any stops enroute except for emergencies.
